

SOW: Season of Witness - Session 4: Profound Conversations

GROUP QUESTIONS

Colossians 4:2-6

1. Have you seen increased signs of your lost friends processing the changes in their lives?
2. When did you last have a 'divine appointment' conversation with someone far from Jesus?
3. What does thankfulness look like in your daily times with God?
4. *"Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity."* (v.5)
How well do you obey each of these two instructions? What holds you back?
5. On a scale of 1 to 10, how competent and confident are you at sharing your faith?
What would help you move up that scale by 1 point?
6. What did you find helpful about the concept of the 6 Gears of Conversation?
7. If your casual conversations with the lost were secretly recorded for a week, what percentage of the time would you be talking?! What would help you become even better at listening?
8. In meaningful conversations, the key is to be authentic and interested. How does this insight help you ask better questions?
9. *"We don't need to know everything. It's how we answer that counts."*
Does how you share your faith reflect this?
10. The goal of this session is that you will consistently move deeper in your conversations with your unchurched friends - from casual to meaningful, or meaningful to spiritual, or spiritual to salvation.
 - Divide into (ideally single sex) groups of 3.
 - First, share and pray together for each of your 3 names of lost friends you're praying for daily.
 - Feedback on what progress you've made in putting 'parties' on your calendars.
 - Discuss when and with whom you will seek to move up to the next conversational gear this week.
 - How can you encourage and support one another as you step out in boldness?
