## GROUP QUESTIONS

*Joshua 1:8*

*Psalms 119:105*

*2 Timothy 3:16-17*

1. It's been said the problem with the Bible is not what is confusing but what is crystal clear! When are you most tempted to 'overlook' what it teaches?
2. As believers we are meant to use our God-given intellects. However, what would be the warning signs that we're turning following Jesus into a mostly intellectual exercise?
3. How can we best equip people to become 'self-feeders' from Scripture?
4. DBS has emerged from the non-Western church. How does it challenge our Western ways of making disciples?
5. In your experience, what is the biggest hindrance to personally applying what God speaks to us about from the Bible?
6. Have you ever read the Bible with someone who wasn't a Christian? What happened?
7. What do you think of the rule that you must stay in the chosen text alone (ie no cross-references)?
8. What do you find hardest about focusing on asking questions rather than bringing answers and teaching?
9. As a group, brainstorm some Bible passages that would make good little series to read with someone who is either considering Christ, or is a new/ young believer.
