OUTCOMES OF R360 ONBOARDING

1. Introduce leadership team to R360

2. Process of setting up R360, creating a survey and generating reports

Objective of Training: The leaders will be able to setup R360 for the church participants and to generate reports.

- Outcome of R360

As a result of the presentation, leaders will increase knowledge about the R360' s measuring four components:

- Spiritual intensity
- Dynamic Relationship
- Missional Alignment
- Cultural Openness



WHAT IS R360

Readiness 360 is an online **survey tool** for mobilizing congregations to multiply in ministry and missional impact in a context.

After a critical mass of the congregants have taken the online survey, the church generates reports of the four components.



FOUR COMPONENTS OF R360

1. Spiritual Intensity

- How could the church help disciples reconnect with God through renewing spiritual practices both personally and as a church body?

2. Dynamic Relationships

- How could we engage in ministry in ways that cultivate trust within the church and relate effectively to folks who are different from the majority of the members?

3. Missional Alignment

- How do we help our people catch where God is calling us as a church to go and how do all our activities, including finances, align with that calling?

4. Cultural Openness

- How do we share the gospel with a diverse population using different cultural containers?

The Readiness 360 timeline in 6 steps

- Identify who you would like to take the survey, providing a broad array of people.
- Determine the timeline that you want your congregation to take the survey.
- Decided on 2 open-ended questions you want to ask and I will add the customized questions into the survey.
- We recommend up to 3 weeks for everyone to complete the survey. Sometimes setting up a computer with the survey on it during Sundays can encourage people to take it and be inclusive of those who are not as computer savvy.

After Survey

- Upon your approval, I will generate 3 reports to close the survey. You may review these with your church council or visioning team, and share appropriately.
 - News Release Report - 1-page of the survey can be shared an email, bulletin and web
 - Executive Summary – to share with church leadership
 - Complete Report – for pastor and church council
- The Church Council and/or Visioning Team can create a plan to address the next faithful steps from the report.
