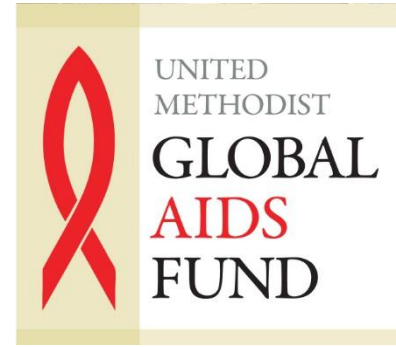
Grant Application for Great Plains UM Global AIDS Funds

Due by Jan. 31

The Great Plains UMC Global AIDS Fund Task Force functions under the umbrella of the Mercy & Justice Team of the Great Plains UMC Conference. Grant funding comes from the 25% of the Global AIDS Fund offering that stays in the Conference.

Requirements:

1. The grant recipient must be a United Methodist Church or an official United Methodist group in the Great Plains Conference. Provide the name of the church/group involved and the contact person’s name, address, phone, and email. State date submitted.
2. A description of the project must be received by **Jan. 31st**, by the Grant Selection Task Force Chair. Request should include:
 - a. A clear goal statement of what the project will accomplish; (The use of “SMART Goal Model” is encouraged.)
 - b. Identifying how the project will address HIV/AIDS;
 - c. Strategies to be used to accomplish the project’s goal;
 - d. Timeline to complete the project; and,
 - e. Amount requested and a budget, including other funding resources or in-kind resources to be used for the project.
3. A written report of the project, due by the **following Jan. 31st**, is to be submitted to the Grant Selection Chair. Failure to submit report results in ineligibility for future funds. This report should include how funds were spent and a publishable “story” about the benefits of the grant.



Grant applications will be reviewed in February. Funding will be determined by the Grant Selection Task Force in accordance with available funds and number of worthy applicants. Funds will be dispersed by the Conference Treasurer.
