

# GREAT PLAINS U.M. CONFERENCE BISHOP'S ROUND-UP AGAINST HUNGER CHANGES & INSTRUCTIONS

*Read before filling out form on the other side*

1. The Bishop's Round-Up Against Hunger will no longer receive general adult and children's clothing at the Roundup Site.
2. We are not soliciting for Crafts, Maternity Clothing or Coats, but if someone brings them, we have places we can send them to. If you donate adult or children's clothing, coats to any **Local** agencies note that at the blank marked "Other" and list the agency.
3. We are anxious to receive **H.U.G.S. (H)ats. (U)nderwear. (G)loves, (S)ocks**  
**Hats** Warm head coverings, for adults or children, male or female. [NEW]  
**Underwear** New Underwear, for adults or children, male or female.[NEW]  
**Gloves** Gloves or Mittens, for adults or children [NEW]  
**Socks** Socks for adults and children [NEW]  
All Children's H.U.G.S. items may be put into the same box, and it should have a RED label on it.  
All Adult H.U.G.S. items may be put into the same box, and it should have a PINK label on it
4. It is **much more important** to list **WHAT** you are giving than **WHO** you gave it to.  
Itemize **WHAT** you gave locally to fit the categories listed on the report.
5. **Cash** Cash donated to the Bishop's Round-Up Against Hunger is generally divided three ways  
40% goes to deal with the root causes for hunger in Haiti  
40% goes to deal with the root causes for hunger in Mexico.  
20% is given in grant form to hunger alleviating agencies in Kansas.



All funds which are designated for Heifer International go directly to that agency.
